

## Community Service Opportunities at St. Christopher's as of November 28, 2011:

### “Food-raiser” for St. Christopher’s Food Bank

**Description:** Earn service hours for turning in a **FULL** grocery-size brown paper bag of items **ONLY** from the following list:

- Canned soup
- Canned meals
- Canned vegetables
- Canned beans
- Tuna
- Spam
- Canned Yams
- Canned Pumpkin
- Cranberry Sauce
- Pasta
- Boxed Mac & Cheese



#### Guidelines for recipients:

1. Must be earning community service hours for a school requirement or other pre-approved situation (by pre-approved, we mean that you have met with one of the Parish Staff and have agreed that participating in this service opportunity will merit you credit according to the prescriptions laid forthwith).
2. Must acquire the food items by themselves such as going door-to-door, grocery shopping, etc.
  - a. Recipient’s parents/guardians may only transport their child but not do the gathering, soliciting, or shopping for them.
3. Cheating in whatever form may result in forfeiting minutes/hours.
4. **BONUS:** Every FULL grocery-size paper bag earns the recipient 2 hours if turned in between now and Friday, Dec. 16. Every Ham or Turkey submitted WITH a full bag of groceries will be an additional hour.
  - a. After Dec. 16, a full bag of groceries will only earn one hour.
5. Must present your “hours sheet/verification form” for an authorized signature the moment the recipient turns in the groceries at any of the Parish offices during office hours, Monday thru Friday. (You may wish to call the office before taking your groceries to church.)
  - a. Understands that failure to do so will forfeit any earned minutes/hours. No exceptions.
  - b. Parents may not turn in the groceries for them and/or present the hours sheet for a signature for their child
6. **If you are enrolled in Faith Formation**, you may submit your groceries to your catechist and earn credit towards your Confirmation.
7. Understands that other rules and terms may be added or changed without notice.
8. The recipient will hold harmless St. Christopher and the Diocese of San Bernardino and its agents and entities for any and all incidences that may arise in participating in this volunteer service opportunity.
9. St. Christopher reserves that right not to give hours or adjust hours for any reason, especially according to the amount of groceries submitted.
